Dodos were birds that lived on the ^(example) island of Mauritius in the Indian Ocean. They are extinct and no longer exist, and not many of their bones remain. We rely on drawings from the 17th century to know what they ⁽¹⁾ _____ like. The drawings show us that these birds had yellow ⁽²⁾ _____, big green beaks, and large bodies. They were ⁽³⁾ _____ - _____ for being fat and clumsy. Scientists today have changed their minds about dodos. They now think that they were perfectly suited to where they lived. They were ⁽⁴⁾ _____ finding food and making nests. On Mauritius, dodos ⁽⁵⁾ _____ had to escape from other animals, because they had no natural predators. There were no people living on the island.
