Marks
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An Amazing Record Breaker

There are many amazing people who have broken world records, but none are as amazing as Ashrita Furman. He has broken more records than anyone else. It started when he read the *Guinness Book of World Records* as a child. From that moment, he only thought of breaking records.

His earliest attempt, in 1978, was to do the most *jumping jacks* or star jumps. He failed, but he didn't give up. Several months later, in early 1979, he did 27,000 jumping jacks and broke the record. Since then, he has set 700 different records. Almost 400 of these have been broken by other people, but he still has 220, including the longest time hula-hooping under water.

Ashrita's teacher tried to make him focus on school work, but instead he spent hours with his friend, Amal. Ashrita's family wanted him to be a doctor, but couldn't do anything to stop his passion. It was Amal who videoed Ashrita's attempts and sent them to Guinness World Records.

Now, Ashrita is 65 years old, but he doesn't plan on stopping soon. He gets up every morning and goes for a five-mile run in the park, which he says keeps him fit enough to break so many world records. Ashrita is quite famous, and is often interviewed in magazines. He also appeared on TV, breaking the record for the most apples cut in half with a sword in a minute. Now, he is training to become the first person to run a marathon while juggling, which he is optimistic about. In the future, he will start his own businesses and teach classes to people who want to achieve amazing things like him.
