(pause 5 seconds)

5. a television (tone)

6. a bowl (tone)

(pause 5 seconds)

Now listen to the first part of the test again **(repeat above)**

Now listen to the second part of the test. **(pause 3 seconds)**

Section L2.

Listen to these six sentences and write the missing word. There is one example.

(very slowly please)

(pause 3 seconds) a. She plays **football** on Saturday. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) b. The children are drinking **milk** in the kitchen. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) c. Their dog is **brown** and white. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) d. Her birthday is in **March**. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) e. There are red **flowers** in the garden. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) f. He is eating a big **salad**. (tone)

(pause 5 seconds)

Now listen to the second part of the test again **(repeat above)**

That is the end of the listening test. You will now have two minutes to check your answers. Your listening paper will then be collected.
