Section L2.

Listen to these six sentences and write the missing word. There is one example.

(very slowly please)

(pause 3 seconds) a. He has a **new** bicycle. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) b. Her birthday is in **March**. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) c. Katie has brown hair and **blue** eyes. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) d. James is drawing a picture of a **cat**. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) e. The **cake** is yellow and pink. (tone)

(pause 3 seconds) f. They play **football** in the park. (tone)

(pause 5 seconds)

Now listen to the second part of the test again (**repeat above**)

That is the end of the listening test. You will now have two minutes to check your answers. Your listening paper will then be collected.
