Section L2.

Listen to the following story.

Put one word in each of the gaps. **(The words below in bold are those that are gapped in the exam paper; they need to be clearly pronounced, although not emphasised)**

**(pause 3 seconds)**

Steven **likes** playing football. He plays football **every** day. On Saturdays, there is a **match** at school. His dad always **watches** it. Steven lives **near** a big park. He rides his bike to this park in the **evening**. Then he plays football with his **best** friend Sam. Sam wears a red T-shirt and Steven wears a **blue** T-shirt. At eight o'clock, Steven goes **home** and has dinner. His favourite is **chicken** and chips. Then he **cleans** his football boots.

**(tone)(pause 3 seconds)**

Now listen to the second part of the test again. **(pause 3 seconds and repeat)**

Now listen to the third part of the test.

Section L3.

Look at the list of names and the box of places. Who goes to this place at the weekend? Listen and write the place next to the name. There is one example. There are two places you do not need to use.

Zoey likes animals and every weekend she goes to the zoo. She never goes to the farm. Vinnie loves swimming. He swims at the swimming pool on Sundays. He doesn't like playing football in the park. Samira often goes to a café with her friend. Samira has cake and a cup of tea in the café. She never buys cake from a shop. Brian goes to the beach every weekend. He likes playing volleyball with his friends on the beach. He never plays in the park. Omar often goes to his favourite shop in the town centre at the weekend. He often buys books and computer games. He doesn't like going to the cinema. Leila loves films. She goes to the cinema every Saturday. She hates going to the shops.

**(pause 3 seconds)**

Now listen to the third part of the test again. **(pause 3 seconds and repeat)**
