Section W1 (10 marks)

Two marks for each correctly formed question, 1 mark for each correct part as divided. Ignore spelling mistakes arising from miscopying.

Section W2 (10 marks - 2 marks for each correctly formed answer – 1 mark if the answer makes sense but is not a full sentence)

Section W3 (10 marks)

Max 2 marks for each relevant sentence which is correctly formed and which is different in structure to the other sentences.

1 mark for each relevant sentence which contains an error, but which is different in structure to the other sentences.

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1 mark for each correctly formed sentence about the topic, but with repeated structure.

½ mark for understandable sentence with one error and repeated structure

For example:

For 2 marks each

1. My house is big/small.
2. There is a kitchen/living room in my house.
3. My house has a nice garden.
4. I share a bedroom with my brother.
5. My favourite room is the living room.

For 1 or 2 marks each

1. My house is big/small. (2)
2. There is kitchen in my house. (1 - no article)
3. My house is nice. (1 - same structure as #1)
4. I am love my house. (1 - verb formation)
5. My favourite room is the living room. (2)

For 1 mark each

1. My house has four bedrooms.
2. My house has a garden.
3. My house has a big kitchen.
4. My house has a swimming pool.
5. My house has two bathrooms.

Section W4 (10 marks – 2 marks for each correctly formed and true statement about the picture; 1 mark for a sentence with [minor] mistakes e.g. use of present simple or omission of article.)

1. The girl is riding (1) a/the bike (1).
2. The boy is carrying (1) a/the cat (1).
3. The man is washing (1) a/the car (1).
4. The rabbit is eating (1) a/the carrot (1).
5. The baby is reading (1) a/the book (1).

Section W5 (10 marks) 1 mark for correct completion of the first 4 spaces on form. 2 marks for question 5, 6 and 7. Allow 1 mark for Q5,6 and 7 with minor errors

1. Any recognisable first name (1)
2. Any recognisable surname (1)
3. Any age. Accept, for example, 10/ten or 10 years [old] (1)
