4. Is Alan / holding the baby?
5. Did they / laugh at the funny film?

Section W2 (10 marks - 2 marks for each correctly formed answer – 1 mark if the answer makes sense but is not a full sentence)

Section W3 (10 marks)

Max 2 marks for each relevant sentence which is correctly formed and which is different in structure to the other sentences.

1 mark for each relevant sentence which contains an error, but which is different in structure to the other sentences.

1 mark for each correctly formed sentence about the topic, but with repeated structure.

½ mark for understandable sentence with one error and repeated structure

For example:

For 2 marks each

1. There are three/four/five in my family.
2. I have two brothers.
3. My sister's name is Mary.
4. My mother/father/sister is kind.
5. I like/love my family.

For 1 or 2 marks each

1. There are five people in my family. (2)
2. I have two brother. (1- missing plural)
3. I have one sister. (1 – same structure as #2)
4. My sister name is Mary (1 – no possessive)
5. I love my family (2)

For 1 mark each

1. My family is big.
2. My family is nice.
3. My family is funny.
4. My family is kind.
5. My family is great!

Section W4 (10 marks – 2 marks for each correctly formed and true statement about the picture; 1 mark for a sentence with [minor] mistakes.)

1. The woman is reading a book.
2. The girl is kicking a ball.
3. The dog is chasing a bird.
4. The cat is climbing a tree.
5. The baby is eating a banana.

Section W5 (10 marks) 1 mark for correct completion of the first 4 spaces on form. 2 marks for question 5, 6 and 7

1. Any recognisable first name
2. Any recognisable surname
3. Any recognisable address – road name and town.
4. Any age. Accept, for example, 10/ten or 10 years [old]
Do not accept DOB
5. Any recognisable place, for example in my bedroom/sitting room/in the garden/at school/at the library.
6. Any recognisable genre –adventure books/books about animals/sports/
titles of books like Harry Potter etc
7. Any feasible number – one, two, three, four, five, eight books etc
