PREPARATION

THE TEST WILL BE LIKE THIS:

Task 1: 2–4 minutes. Introductory warm-up

The assessor will ask you to introduce yourself and say a little about who you are, what you like doing and so on. Be prepared to ask the other candidate questions about his/her hobbies, ambitions and so on.

Task 2: 8–10 minutes. Prepared discussion

You and the other candidate will each give your three-minute presentation in turn. You should then be prepared to engage in a discussion about your chosen topics.

Task 3: about 8 minutes. Unprepared discussion

You will be given a task to complete with the other candidate. You will both be given some information or facts and by negotiation and discussion you must make some decisions together about your priorities.
